We would also consider Italian speakers as long as they are willing to learn a little bit of English so as to communicate with English speaking customers. Must be customer orientated, have a pleasant appearance and personality, be ready to work as part of a team. You must have at least 1 year experience as a butcher.

We would be willing to pay for the first month of accommodation, so that the candidate can have some time to settle down.

Any other benefits

You would be entitled to 28 days of paid leave, 12 days of Paid sick leave and 36 days of half pay sick leave should the need arise. You would also be covered by insurance. A government bonus of € 512.52 annually will also be paid. This is divided in four payments. You would be working in a stable environment with peace of mind that your job is secure long term.

Salary

Your pay packet would be around € 15,000 annually for the first 40 hours worked. You would also be able to increase this by working overtime, which is paid at an hourly rate of 1.5 times your normal hourly rate during normal working hours and double the hourly rate on Sundays and Public Holidays. Overtime is always available.
