Job Overview: The Innovation Manager will build and manage a small team of people, leading the activities of ResourSEAs within international research projects, in which the ResourSEAs technology will be implemented on a prototype scale. The main focus will be on the production of magnesium compounds from waste brines. The Innovation Manager will also establish relationships with end-users, ensuring that the final products meet their requirements and will develop a strategic plan towards building a scaled-up production plant and providing the products to the market.

Responsibilities and Duties

The Innovation Manager will have a varied role, adapting to day-to-day requirements. Some of the responsibilities include but are not limited to:
